COOKIE POLICY

Our Site uses cookies and/or other similar technologies such as device IDs, pixel tags and web beacons to collect and store information about you.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are pieces of information or code that a website transfers to or accesses from your computer or device to store, and sometimes track, information about you.

Cookies let websites remember you and your preferences, manage different features and content, store searches, and personalise content.

HOW DOES OUR SITE USE COOKIES?

Our Site uses cookies (alone or combined) to create a unique device ID and to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to improve your experience and improve our Site. We also use cookies to keep our Site secure and to understand how users navigate around the Site.

Some cookies only last while you use our Site. Some cookies are used to remember you when you visit again and will last for longer.

We use strictly necessary cookies if it is in our legitimate interests to do so (balanced with your rights). These are cookies where the storage of (or access to) information is essential rather than reasonably necessary. For instance, we need to use these cookies in order to provide a service to you. Additionally, these cookies can be strictly necessary in order to comply with a legal obligation that we are subject to.

We use all other cookies with your consent. You can choose which cookies to consent to through our Privacy Preference Centre which is available to you through our website.

WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE?

We use the following types of cookies:

Functional, Analytical and Advertising cookies.

FUNCTIONAL COOKIES

Functional Cookies are essential for you to be able to move around the Website and use its functions. These Cookies enable the different functions of the Website, make your browsing more secure or provide functionalities that were previously requested by you. As they are necessary for the operation of the Website, these Cookies are enabled by default and cannot be refused.

We may use Cookies necessary to save your selection of Cookies in our Privacy Preference Centre, to stabilize your navigation or to make it more secure.

PRIVACY PREFERENCE CENTRE

DISABLING COOKIES

Microsoft Internet Explorer

- 1. Select the Tools menu > Internet Options
- 2. Click on the Privacy tab
- 3. Click on Advanced within the Settings section and select the appropriate setting

Google Chrome

- 1. Select Settings > Advanced
- 2. Under Privacy and Security > Content settings.
- 3. Click Cookies and select the relevant options



Safari

- 1. Select Preferences > Privacy
- 2. Click on Remove all Website Data

Mozilla Firefox

- 1. Choose the Tools menu > Options
- 2. Click on the Privacy icon
- 3. Select the Cookie menu and select the relevant options

Opera 6.0 and further

- 1. Choose Files menu > Preferences
- 2. Select Privacy
